

Fort Riley Child and Youth School Services looking for qualified Instructors!

SKIES*Unlimited* is part of Fort Riley Child, Youth, and School Services (CYSS), a division of U.S. Army Family, Morale, Welfare and Recreation (FMWR) Directorate.

The SKIES*Unlimited* instructional program is structured into 4 “schools”:
School of Fine Arts, Recreation, and Leisure
School of Sports, Fitness, and Health
School of Academic Skills, Mentoring, and Intervention
School of Life Skills, Citizenship, and Leadership

SKIES classes are for children ages infant through 18 years.

The instructor determines course content (with program director’s approval), schedule, student ages, minimum and maximum enrollment (within CYSS adult-child ratio requirements) and cost per session/month. Instructors must provide evidence of credentials to teach college transcripts, professional organization membership/accreditation, certificates of training, references, etc.

Classes can be as short as one morning or afternoon, or extend throughout the school year. Most school year classes are offered in 6 to 8 week sessions, with 1-2 class meetings each week. Instructors are considered paid contractors.
