Hear about space exploration adventures firsthand from someone who has experienced a launch and the wild ride into orbit. This meal opportunity, currently offered every day of the week at 12:15 p.m. at the Visitor Complex, includes a banquet-style lunch with a speaking appearance by a real Astronaut hero. This popular program incorporates a fun video of Astronauts living and working in space, a brief presentation on his/her experiences, and Question and Answer period. The meal is topped off by a wonderful selection of desserts. Guests even receive an autographed souvenir to take home! The program runs approximately 1 hour and adds a very "exclusive" feel to the day at Kennedy Space Center.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Where do our guests redeem their vouchers or consignment tickets?

A: The guest will take their voucher up to will call (ticket windows 1 through 4).

Q: What does the admission ticket include?

A: The ticket is a 1-day ticket with a 2nd day free to be used within 7 days of the initial visit. It includes both **IMAX** films, the *new Shuttle Launch Experience* and all museum shows and exhibits. In addition, it includes the general bus tour that goes to the **LC-39 Observation Gantry**, the **Saturn V Facility** and the **International Space Station Facility**. Admission also includes the **U.S. Astronaut Hall of Fame**.

Q: How do I make reservations for special interest tours (NASA Up Close or Cape Canaveral Then and Now Tour), Space Pass, or Lunch with an Astronaut?

Advance reservations are required for the NASA Up Close or Cape Canaveral Then and Now Tour. To make reservations for your guest, call **866-737-5235**. Please write the reservation number on the voucher.

Q: What time does the last bus tour leave the Visitors Complex?

A: The last bus departs the bus terminal at approximately 2:30pm.

Q: Where can the guest with a voucher watch the shuttle launches?

A: The guest can use the voucher to view the launch from the Astronaut Hall of Fame (7.5 mile view).

Q: Where can the guest with a voucher watch a rocket launch?

A: The guest can use the voucher to view the rocket launch from the Visitor Complex (6 mile view).

Q: What is the age for a child admission?

A: Children ages 3 to 11 years old. Children under 3 are Free.
